
We will obtain these goals by increasing professional development and reviewing our data in depth. We will be training our teachers on utilizing data to impact our quality instruction more intently.

Percent Passing both ELA and Math




Percent Passing BOTH ELA and Math 2018-19





Grade 3 Percent Passing ISTEP+/ILEARN




GRADE 4 PERCENT PASSING

Grade 4 Percent Passing ISTEP+/ ILEARN




